



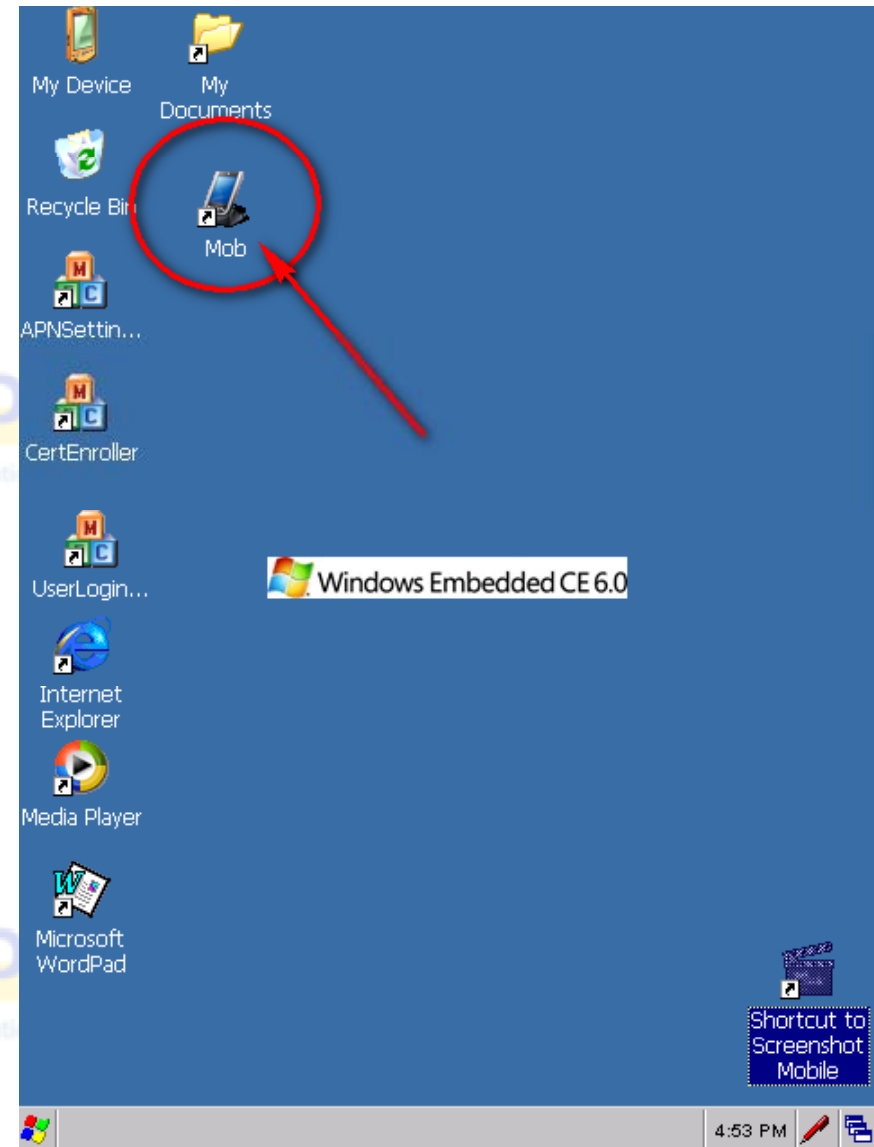

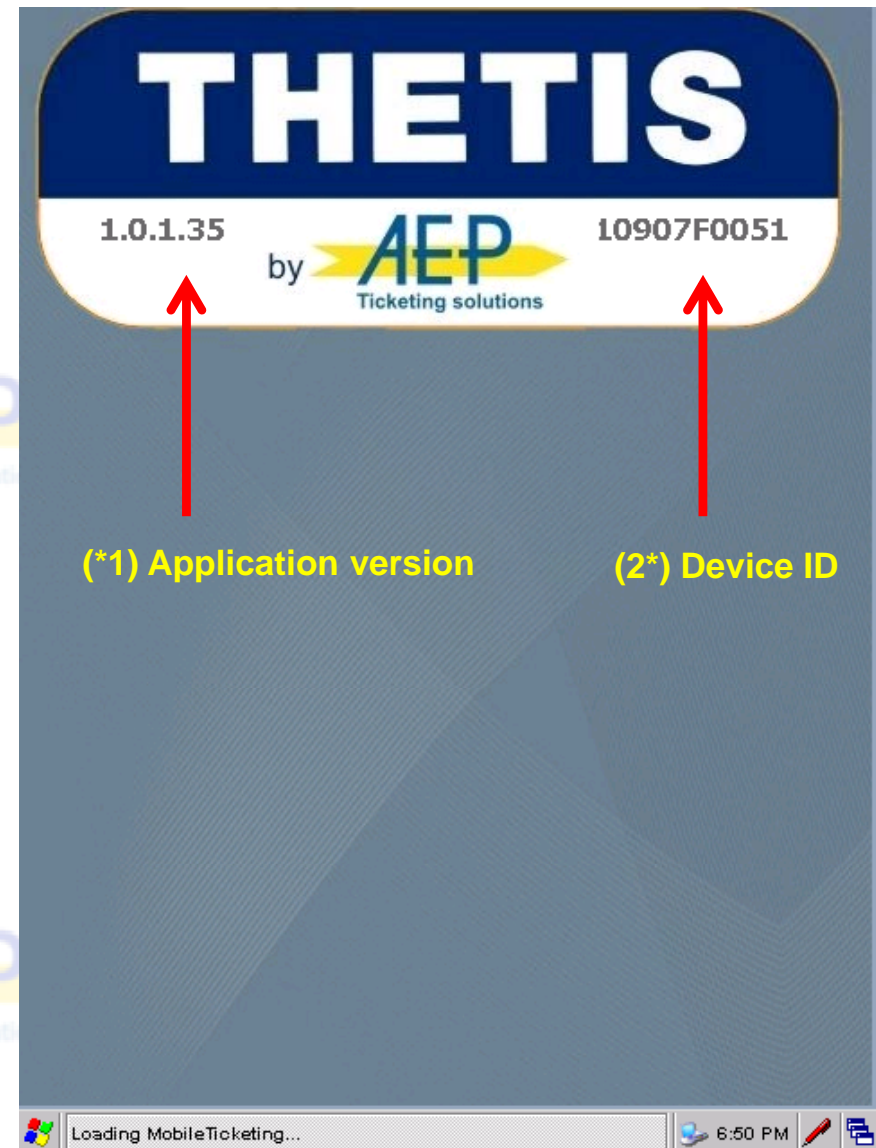
To launch the application

- To execute the application, click on the desktop icon «Mob».



Initial splash screen

- When it is launched for the first time, a splash screen is shown for a few seconds.
- During the splash screen the application checks for database consistency and loads data.
- The number on the left side means the application version (*1), the one on the right side is the device unique id (*2).

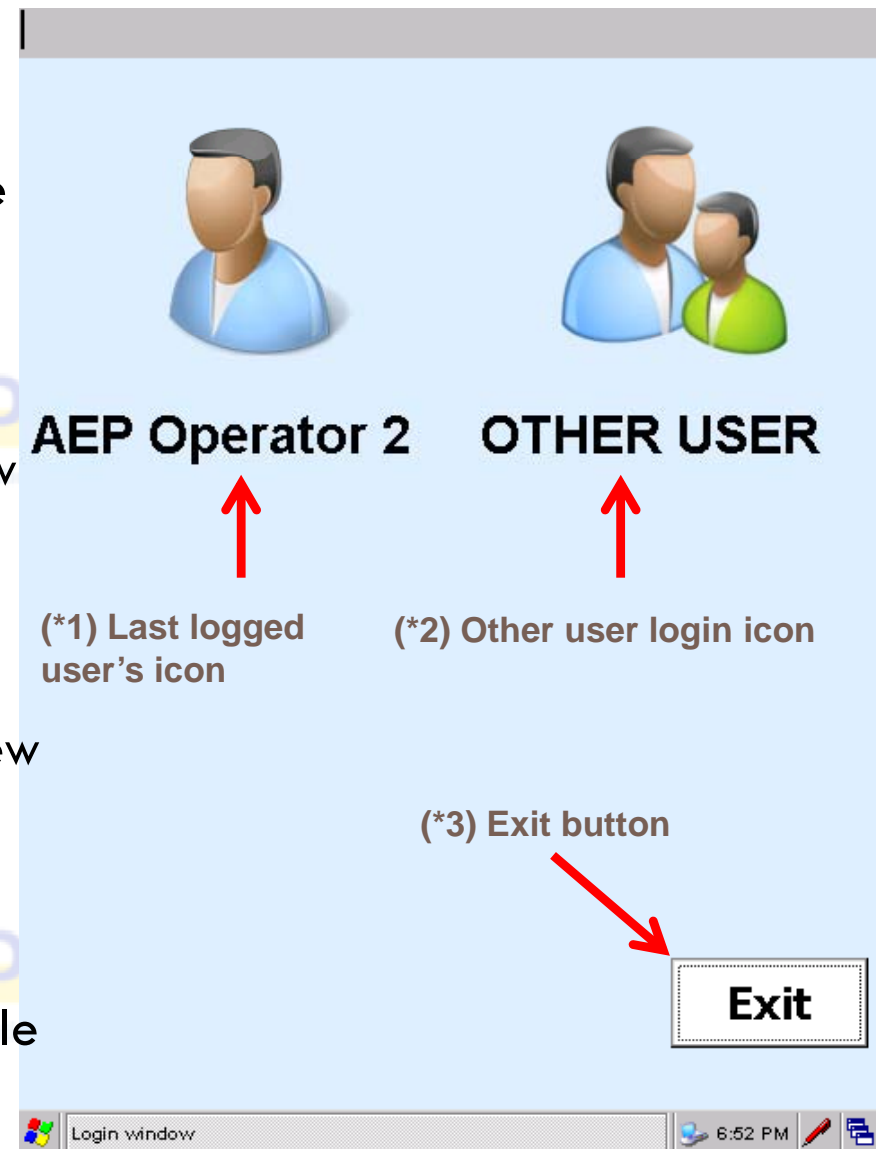


(*1) Application version

(*2) Device ID


Login page

- The login page shows two icons: the left one (*1) allows the last operator that has logged on the terminal to login again, the right one (*2) allows other operators to login.
- Clicking on «AEP Operator 2» icon, a new window is opened and the user can digit only the password.
- Clicking on «OTHER USER» (*2) icon, a new window is opened and the user can digit username and password.
- Clicking the «Exit» button (*3) it is possible to quit the application.



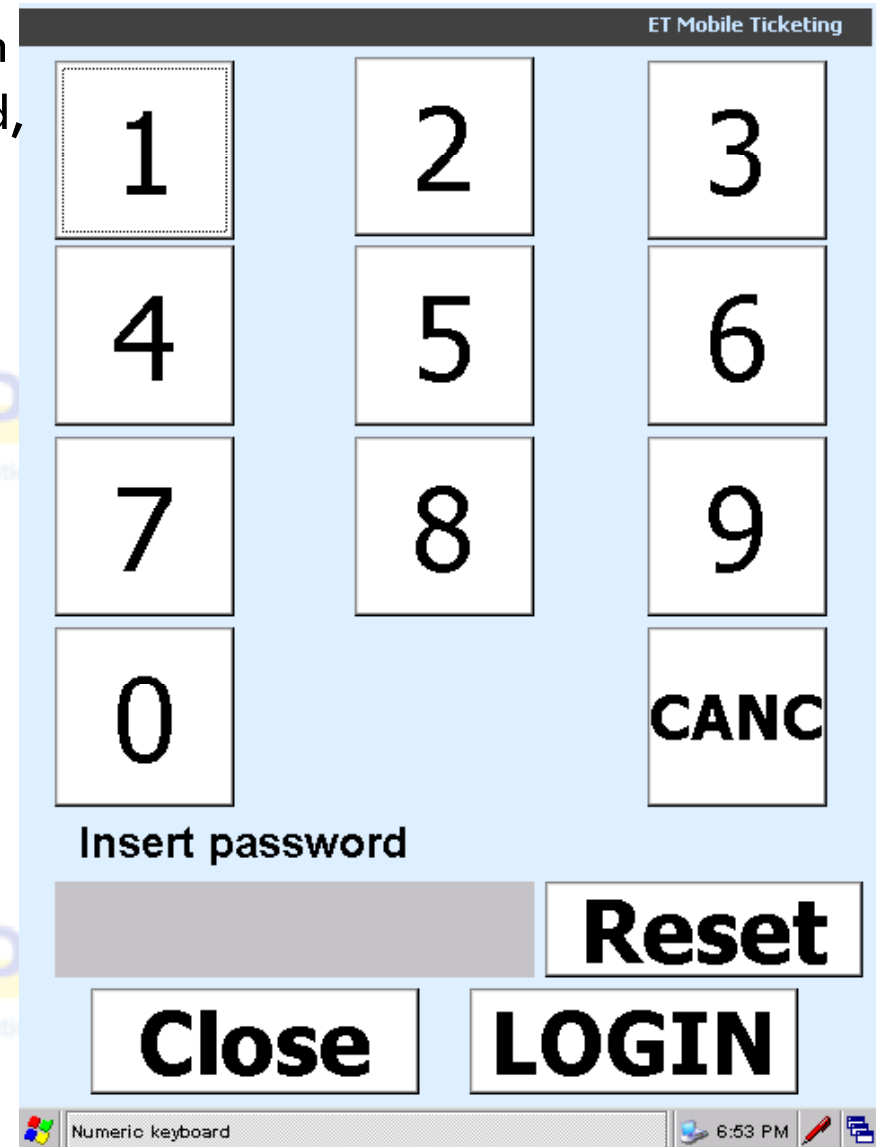
Other user «Login page»

- ❑ Login page allows the user to digit username and password and to login.
- ❑ Before entering the username, click on the button (*1) next to the Username label.
- ❑ Before entering the password, click on the button (*2) next to the Password label.
- ❑ Then click on the LOGIN button (*3).
- ❑ To close the window and return back to login page, click Close button (*4)



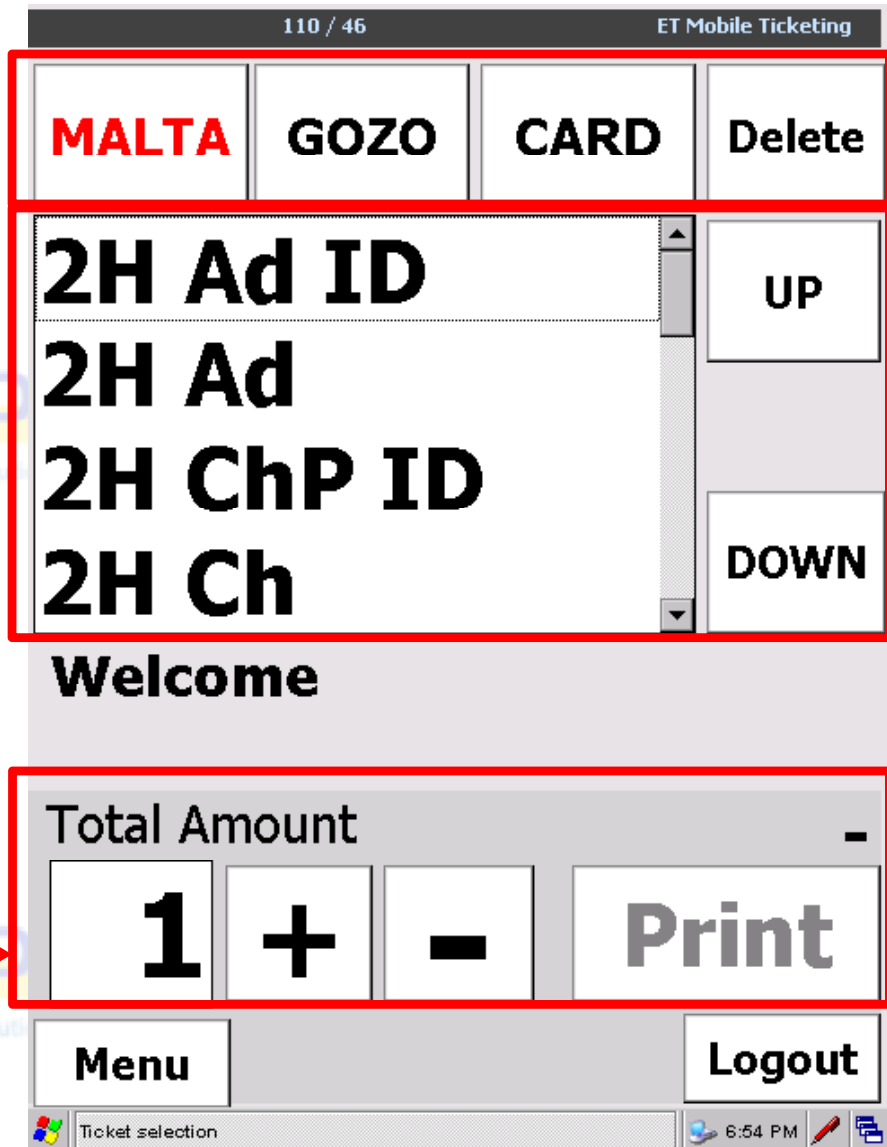
Username and Password input page

- The username and password can typed in a proprietary full screen virtual keyboard, very easy to use.
- The physical keyboard and the Windows CE keyboard are not used.



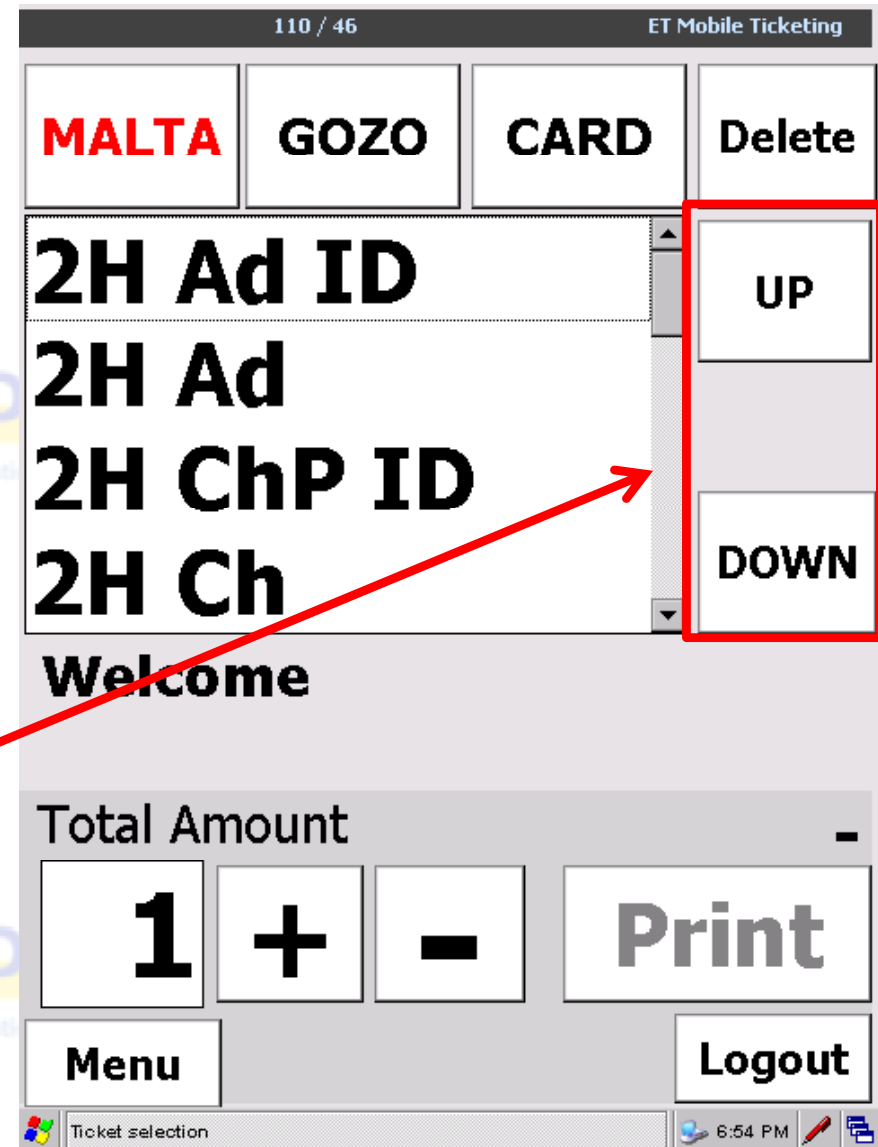
Main page

- Main page allows the user to access all program functions in a single page.
- On the top section the user can choose between Malta, Gozo and SmartCard tickets.
- The central part shows a list of tickets.
- In the bottom part the user can change the number of tickets and prints them.




Main page (top section)

- In the top section the user decides which kind of ticket has to be printed.
- It is possible to click on the three buttons: «MALTA», «GOZO» and «CARD».
- When the user click on the desidered button, the list of tickets is updated.
- Using Up and Down buttons it's possible to change the current page in the ticket list.



Main page (Gozo ticket list)

- Clicking on «GOZO» button, the ticket list is immediatly refreshed with new tickets.





Main page (select the ticket)


- To select the ticket just click on it. A full description is at the bottom of the list. The amount and the price of the ticket are updated together.

Main page (change number of tickets)


- Clicking + and – the user increases and decreases the number of tickets to print. The amount is automatically refreshed.


Main page (delete a ticket)

- Clicking the «DELETE» button a new windows is opened where the user can delete a previously printed ticket.



Main page (delete a ticket)

- The ticket list is showed and can be printed by clicking «PRINT HISTORY» button (*1).
- To delete a ticket, select the row and click the «DELETE» button (*2).
- The list can be scrolled using «UP» and «DOWN» button (*3).
- Finally click on «CLOSE» button (*4) to return to the previous page.

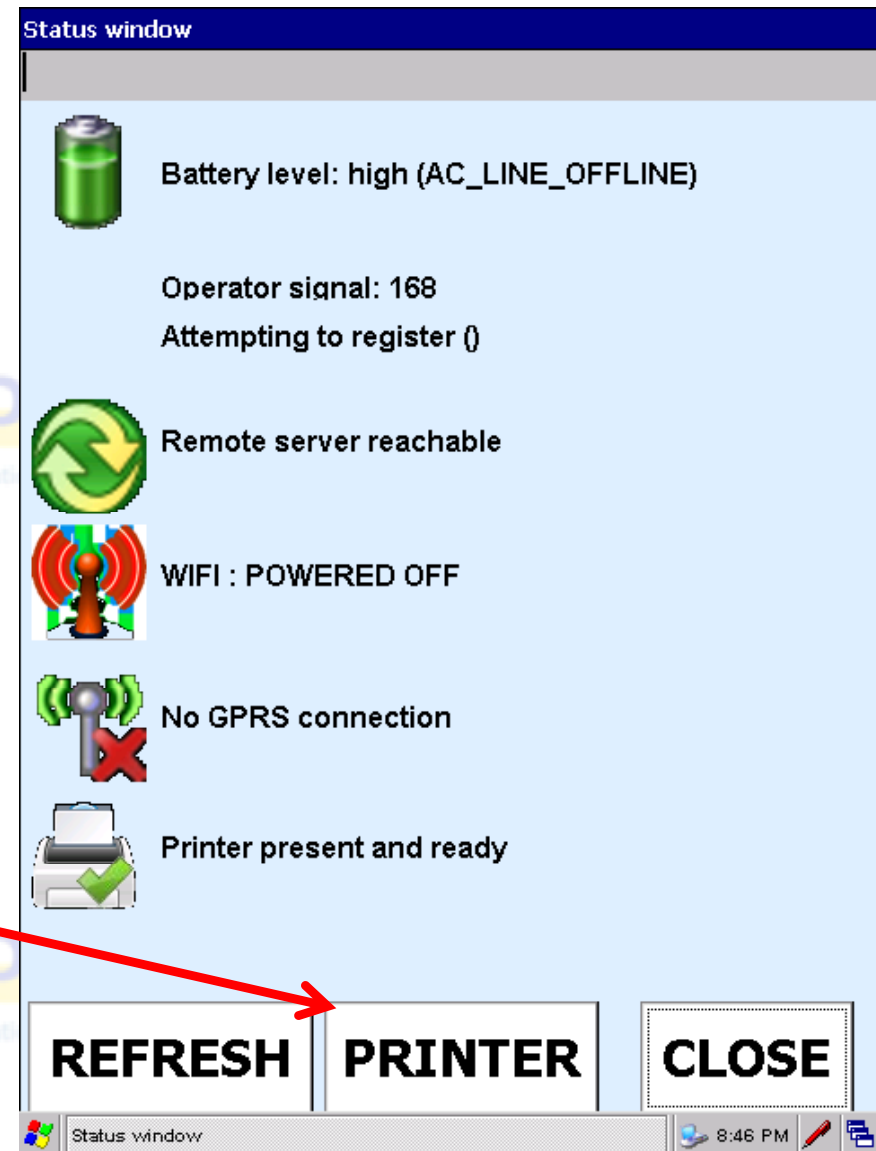

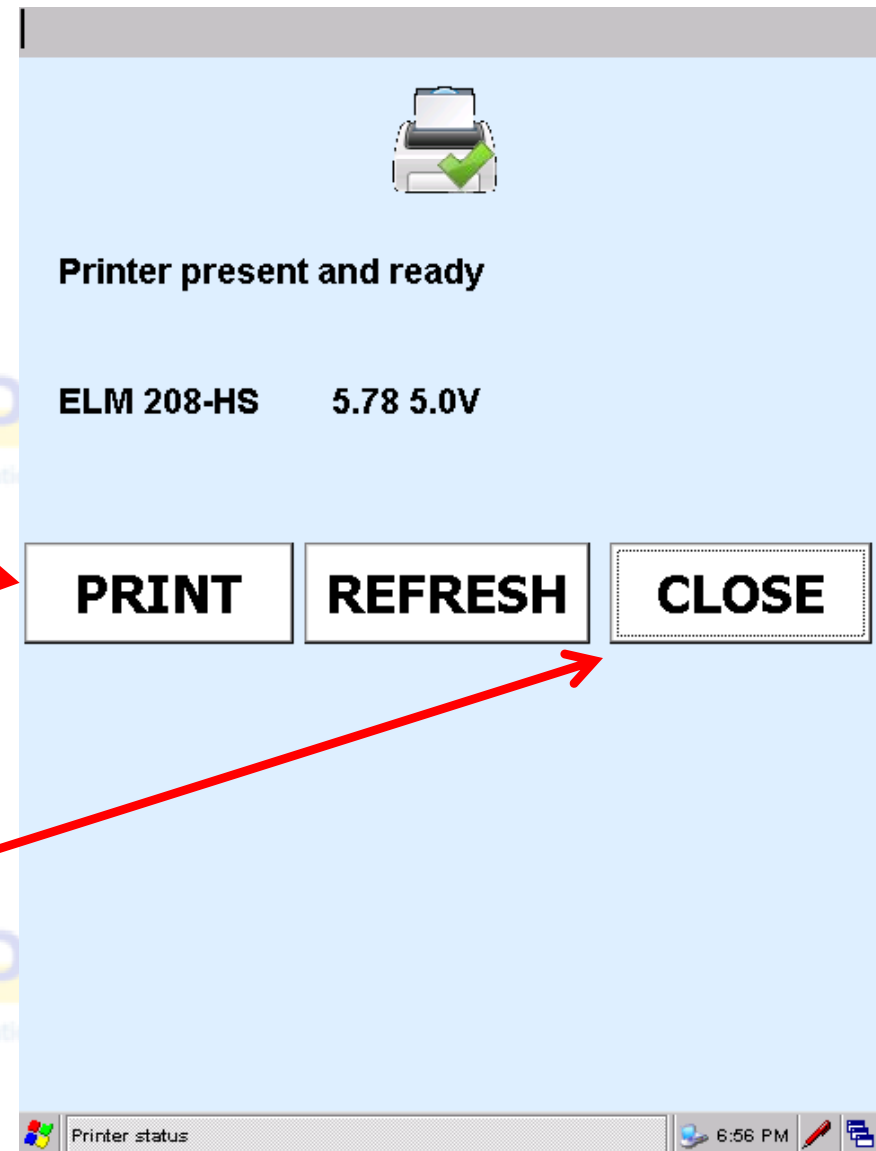
Service window

- Service windows can be opened from every location by clicking on «MENU» button.
- This window shows the hardware details and the connection state.
- Clicking on the «PRINTER» button a new window is opened.



Printer status window

- This window shows the printer status.
- It is possible to print a test ticket by clicking on the «PRINT» button.
- To return back to the service window, click on «CLOSE» button.



Close the shift and print the ticket history

- When the user ends the shift, the terminal can be logout.
- Clicking on «Logout» button a ticket with the user activity is printed and the shift is closed.
- The program logouts the user and returns back the initial login window.
